Whether we are new, returning, or at Shalimar United Methodist Church for a long time I would like to extend an invitation, "Let us be "ALL IN" for JESUS!"

In the words of Mark Batterson, "We are one decision away from a totally different life." This decision is to give our life to Jesus without holding anything back. This is the premise of the book *ALL IN* that will be our subject of the new sermon series and resource for our new small group study.

What does it mean to be all in? I do remember a story in my life that illustrates holding back. When I was in the tenth grade, I began practicing varsity football. Years later as pastor, I have often thought of the same analogy in the church. How many of us are holding back from being the person God wants us to become? How many people are comfortable keeping a safe distance from God but inwardly their lives are miserable. Are there those of us who are committed to being good but we are holding back in one area that keeps us from being "ALL IN." Someone once said the hardest part of a commitment is the final six inches. Imagine jumping in and making a 100% commitment to Jesus. What would happen if we totally offer to God what we have been reluctant to offer in the past? I agree with Mark Batterson's premise in his book, we are one decision away from a totally different life!

What would Shalimar United Methodist look like if hundreds of us went "ALL IN" with our relationship with Jesus at the same time. Our church would impact this community like never before! This is our hope for the new series. Our sermons will be purposely challenging! Our small grous will be engaging, and our lives may never be the same.

Are we ready to be "ALL IN" for JESUS! It is time! Let's be ALL IN for Jesus!

"The Christian faith is not boring, mundane, or safe. It is the greatest adventure any human being can ever experience. It demands all you have and are, and then it demands more."

Have you ever looked at other Christians and wished you could have a bold walk with Christ as they do? Who in your life have you admired as God-fearing people?

Christ came to this earth and gave us everything. He was born like us, lived like us, but died a death worse than we will ever die, so that we can live forever with our Father in heaven.

In our passage this week, Matthew 19:20-26, Jesus is speaking to a young man who wants to follow him but is still attached to things of this world. Mark Batterson talks in his book about the things in this world that hold us back. Many times, it is things that God has given us, blessings, which take hold of us and become more important than God.
