We have added three new staff members, purchased the Presbyterian property next door, and have active master planning moving toward a recommendation. These are just some of the exciting things on the horizon. Shalimar UMC is one exciting church to be a part of these days. I'm looking forward to sharing these unprecedented days with you. May God's love surround, grace abound, and work astound! May we have the wisdom from above in all things.

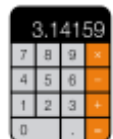
