Philip's Focus

Jesus Is the Same Yesterday, Today, and Forever

Shalimar United Methodist Church was founded in 1951 to reach this geographical area for Jesus. Our church has been blessed with tremendous growth since the humble origins of the first worship service in a Drive-In concession stand. Sixty-seven years later we find our church on the horizon of perhaps unprecedented opportunities and challenges. What we are doing now is going to greatly impact our future!

Our church is committed to grow in the future. In planning future growth we have both realities and opportunities. A few months ago Reverend Jeff Spiller consulted with us about our future growth. One of his most notable statements was, "A church is kidding itself if it thinks it will grow without increasing the number of first time visitors." The reason is, first time visitors are one of best indicators of future growth. How do we increase our number of first time visitors? The world has changed since 1951. Back in the day, first time visitors used to come in great numbers upon seeing the presence of a church. People took the initiative to worship in the local church. Today, very few first time visitors just come on their own initiative to visit.

The reality of less first time visitors does not mean greater numbers of first time visitors are no longer possible; it does indicate the need of a different strategy. **In short, instead of expecting people to come to us we must go to them.** Our church's future will depend on us going to the people and offering deeds of kindness to initiate new relationships. People need Jesus more than ever. As we offer deeds of shalom, we will influence for Jesus, and the Kingdom, and our church will grow as a result.

Our future playbook can be found in the pages of Acts. The Book of Acts tells us the story of the birth, growth, and expansion of the early Church. In these stories and teachings we discover the KEYS to the Kingdom. Our new series, *Keys to the Kingdom...Unlocking the Future of our Church*, will teach us about the past and offer both keys to our present and future.

On my desk for many years I kept the verse from Hebrews 13:8 for inspiration, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever." The world constantly changes but the good news of Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever. The future of our church is living for Jesus in our community and world one person at a time, and one deed at a time, and empowering our whole congregation to be witnesses all the time!

This series has the opportunity to be transforming for both our church and community. I'm challenging us to do three things:

- Pray every day for our church as we seek to empower every person in our church to offer Christ in our community by our deeds of shalom. These deeds will largely be unspoken without a lot of words. In fact, fewer words will draw more attention to our actions which will be our deeds of shalom. We will have specific examples of deeds of shalom as the series progresses.
- Invite friends, acquaintances, neighbors, and relatives to be with us at Shalimar UMC! This is a great time to come into Shalimar!
- Be at worship all six Sundays, unless prevented, to learn about how to incorporate the deeds of shalom in our everyday life.

I look forward to growing with you in implementing this new strategy! **One person at a time, one deed at a time, and empowering our whole congregation to be witnesses all the time!**



This Week's Guide for Groups & Individuals

How is God working in your life right now? If you take a moment to read through Acts 1-4, you'll notice that the early church spread the Good News of Jesus Christ through not just preaching but also through prayer and through spending time together. That time together gave them a chance to show new Christians what it meant to follow Christ. They also were able to answer questions and encourage one another.

In chapter 2, Peter preaches and people respond by giving their lives over to God: this action fulfilled Christ's prediction when he said that Peter would be the rock which Christ's church would be built.

Read Matthew 16:17-19.

- What do you think Jesus meant by "keys to the Kingdom of Heaven"?
- How do we share with others that Heaven is open to all if we receive God's truth?
- When was the last time you shared with someone the things God was doing in your life?

Read Acts 2:36-41.

- How would you have felt if you heard Peter's words that day?
- When was the last time something pierced your heart and brought you to the feet of Jesus?
- What can you pray for today that will cause the Holy Spirit to move in your life?

Read Acts 2:42-47.

- What do you picture when you read this description of the first Christian community?
- How can we create a community like this?
- How can we invite people who have never been a part of the Church to join us in our Christian family?

Pray and ask God to show you someone this week that you need to start reaching out to over the course of the next 5 weeks, getting to know, praying for, supporting, and being the church for.


