Upcoming Events This Week

Our Bishop, David Graves, will be leading a town hall meeting for the Pensacola District this Sunday, October 7th. The event will be held at 3:00 pm and hosted by Navarre United Methodist Church. This event is important. I'm asking those of you concerned about the upcoming General Conference to attend. I will also be attending and will look forward to hearing from our Resident Bishop. The Town Hall meeting is open to all. My hope is attending this session will lessen some of the anxiety about the upcoming General Conference in St. Louis in February. As we approach General Conference, we are facing some other unknowns about the future. We are preparing to initiate the beginning phase of our Master Plan in 2019. Our church is anticipating a capital campaign also in 2019. 
