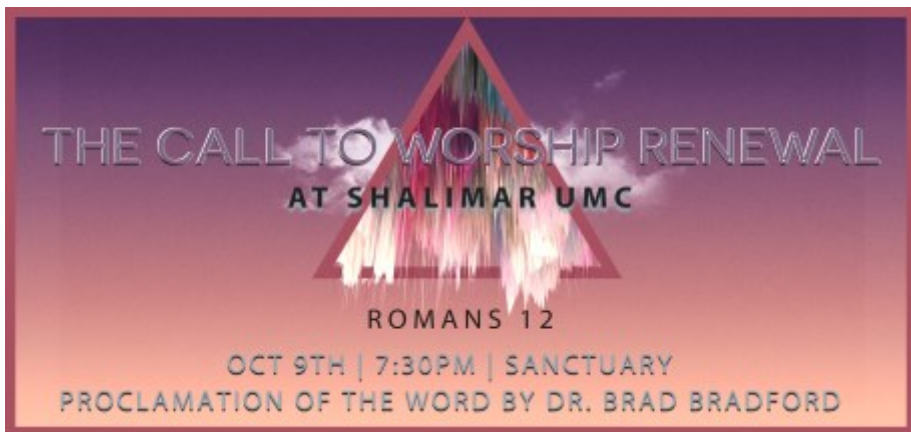

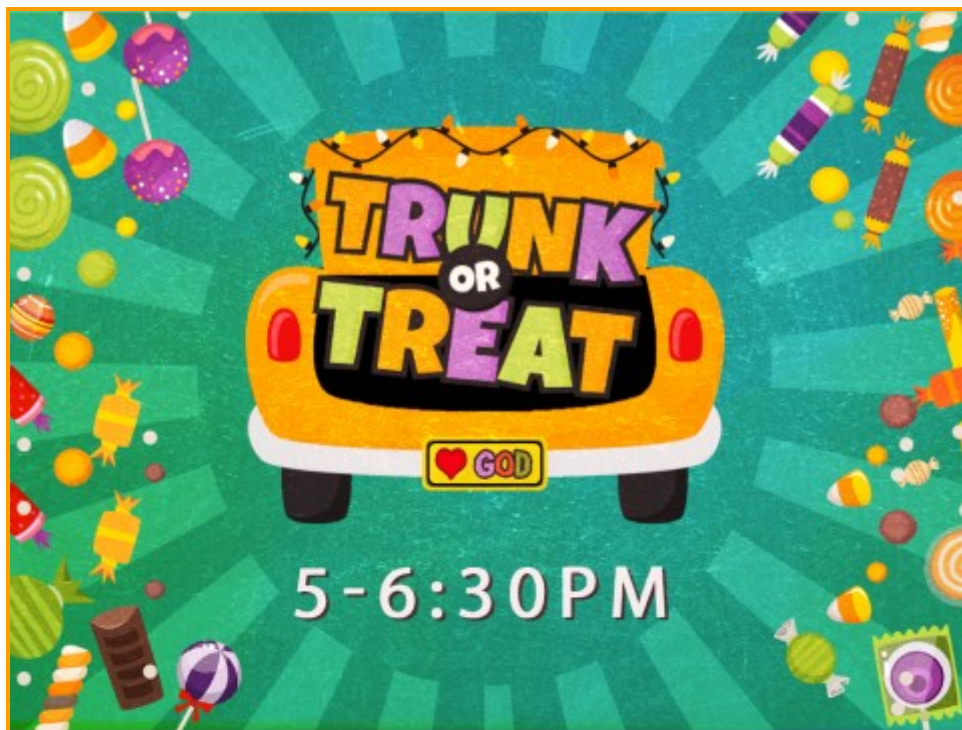

A Newsletter From the Bishop

Friends,

As we draw closer to October 10, the anniversary of Hurricane Michael, a multitude of emotions race through my head. Some of you watched from afar and experienced the uncertainty if friends or loved ones were safe, while some of you were quite literally in the eye of the storm. It took days to assess the safety of our clergy and their families, as well as the condition of United Methodist churches along the Florida Panhandle. Our conference leadership team and I visited the area as soon as it was deemed safe to enter. If you did not see the devastation in person, there are simply no words to express the destruction and chaos that Hurricane Michael left behind. It was a helpless feeling. As your Bishop, I am supposed to have answers and plans to lead you through times of despair but even the best plans cannot prepare you for a category five hurricane.



As I reflect on this past year, I am so humbled to see the progress in the panhandle communities. It will take years to rebuild but little by little, we have come so far. For that progress, I give thanks and celebrate the thousands of people who contributed their gifts, service and witness. From clergy in surrounding areas who quickly mobilized supplies and figured out delivery logistics; to our clergy in the damaged areas who put their own personal needs aside to help their church members and communities; to conference staff and the Hurricane Michael recovery team; I am reminded of the need for this connection. If you simply gave \$10 or donated a toothbrush, you made a difference. I've said it before and I will say it again: we are at our best in the worst of times.

We have a long-term commitment to this area, that we will walk alongside these communities until there is no longer a need. We still need your help. We invite you to pray with us, make a donation and send teams. More information can be found at www.hurricanemichaelrecovery.org. The local church is where our vital ministries are. Join me in making this recovery process a priority. I give thanks to your church for your participation and leadership.

How We Are Hearing the “Cry of the Needy”



On communion Sundays, we say a Prayer of Confession and Pardon and ask God to forgive us for having “failed to be an obedient church” and include the painful line, “we have not heard the cry of the needy.” Throughout the years, Shalimar UMC has carried out God’s command to do His will and love their neighbors. There is scarcely a non-profit organization around that could operate without the volunteers that come from this church family. SUMC has an ongoing history of events, groups, and individuals that live out “in joyful obedience” service to others. Faith Backpacks, Bus Ministry, REBOOT, Grief Share, Prayer ministry, Stephen Ministry are only just a few.

Blessings for Children is an SUMC Missions ministry, and with your support is striving to hear “the cry of the needy” by serving children in need. Children ages newborn through 5th grade are served with clothing, personal care items, and school supplies. Each Wednesday from noon to 3:30 pm in the #10 2nd Street house behind the church, volunteers meet with these families and share God’s love and hope. They talk with them, hear their prayer concerns, meet their practical needs, offer Christian materials and invite them to participate in our church’s offerings. In short, we connect them with the love and hope of God.

We are able to do this because our church hears “the cry of the needy.” Through this ministry, we have provided 160+ services to meet the needs of 90+ children (many repeat visitors) since we opened in January 2019.
