

Lewis' tremendous intellect was wedded to a powerful imagination and in those flights of literary fantasy, his deepest perceptions of God were birthed and came alive. Even generations after his death, C.S. Lewis continues to be numbered among our best selling authors.

You are familiar with many of his writings...Chronicles of Narnia; Mere Christianity; Surprised by Joy; The Weight of Glory; The Screwtape Letters; Till We Have Faces and many more.
