	COURSE DESCRIPTION	DURATION
ERT FIRST AID/CPR REFRESHER	A comprehensive video supported review of common first aid, adult CPR and Pediatric CPR practices	2HRS
ERT INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM	An introduction to National Incident Management System (NIMS) and Incident Command System (ICS) principles. This course provides basic information related to Basecamp Incident Coordination. It prepares the student to participate in ERT coordination, support, tasking, and logistic control to promote smooth operations and interface with State/Local Emergency Operations Centers (EOC) and Emergency Support Functions (ESF) at the Local and District and State level.	2HRS
DAMAGE ASSESSMENT TRAINING	An ERT 200 course to prepare the student to conduct initial damage assessments in the field prior to ERT deployment	2HRS
TEAM LEADER TRAINING	An ERT 200 course to prepare the student to lead and support a field deployed Early Response Team	2HRS
HANDS ON TARPING/LADDERING (offered once before lunch and once after lunch)	This is a hands on outside training reviewing techniques and procedures for laddering buildings and installing damage mitigation tarps (Blue Roofs) to prevent water intrusion and minimize damage.	2HRS
